

# M20 Summit - guide for delegates

#### **About the M20 Initiative**

The  $\underline{\text{M20}}$  is an independent initiative designed to elevate media, journalism, and information integrity issues within the G20 policy agenda.

The highlight of the 2025 M20 programme is the M20 Summit, a two-day international conference which amplifies the voices of emerging G20 economies, African and other media stakeholders in exploring actionable proposals that align with the priorities of the G20 and unique challenges faced by developing nations.

The Summit topics cover the issues raised in the M20 policy briefs, and other matters related to the role of media and information integrity in the G20.

The Summit brings together journalists, academics, policymakers, civil society actors, and media practitioners to engage in collaborative dialogue and shape global media governance policy.

# Summit venue and registration

The M20 Summit will take place at <u>The Venue</u> at <u>17 The High Street, Melrose Arch,</u>
<u>Johannesburg</u>, starting with a welcome dinner on 31 August and the Summit on 1 and 2
September.

Located in the vibrant and secure Melrose Arch precinct, The Venue is a modern event space with state-of-the-art facilities. It is pedestrian-friendly and surrounded by high-end shops, restaurants, and hotels, with secure 24/7 parking.

Refreshments during coffee breaks and lunch will be catered for at the summit as well as the Sunday evening dinner and the dinner on the 1<sup>st</sup> of September.

Registration will be open from 8am on day 1 and 8.30 on day 2 and both days' proceedings will start at 08:45 and end at 17:30.

# **Transportation & shuttle services**

Arriving at the airport you can either book a shuttle in advance or use the airport train service or an e-hailing service.

- E-hailing services like Uber are widely available and usually safe to use throughout Johannesburg. The airport information desk can help guide you to the e-hailing service pick-up points.
- Another option is to take the <u>Gautrain</u> at the airport to Sandton or Rosebank stations and then Uber to Melrose Arch.
- Or use <u>EZ Shuttle</u>: mail them in advance on <u>info@ezshuttle.co.za</u> to book trips for airport transfers and hotel-to-venue shuttles but please book in advance to secure preferred time slots.

### **Accommodation recommendations**

All hotels listed below are within walking distance or a short drive from the summit venue:

Hotel Name Approx. Distance

<u>Protea Hotel Fire & Ice Melrose Arch</u> ~300 m

<u>The Capital Melrose</u> ~500 m

Melrose Place Boutique Hotel / Guest Lodge ~1.2 km

<u>Johannesburg Marriott Hotel Melrose Arch</u> ~1.2 km



# Weather forecast & packing guidance

# Spring weather in Johannesburg (early September):

- Daytime temperatures: 20°C 25°C (68°F 77°F)
- Evening temperatures: Around 10°C (50°F)

# **Recommended packing:**

- Light layers for daytime comfort
- A warm jacket or sweater for cooler evenings
- Comfortable walking shoes

# **Emergency and local services**

- Nearest Hospital: Netcare Rosebank Hospital (~10 minutes by car)
